₹5k fine on caterer for poor meals in train

The Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) has levied a fine of ₹5,000 on a caterer for the inadequate provision of curd and substandard meals to passengers on train 12146 from Puri (Odisha) to Lokmanya Tilak Terminus (LTT). Additionally, the IRCTC has issued a stern warning, indicating the possibility of further penal actions in case of a recurrence of such incidents.

Anuj Kumar Gupta, a resident of Koparkhairane, filed a complaint through the centralised public grievance redress and monitoring system (CPGRAMS) after experiencing poor-quality food during

● The catering service provider, M/s R K Associates & Hoteliers, contends that the food prices were sourced from an unauthorised vendor, but the veg meal was supplied at the correct MRP and passed quality checks

his journey on September 29. Gupta's complaint alleges that the caterer was selling food items priced at ₹150 each, which were listed at ₹80, and failing to provide a proper bill. Upon confronting Santosh Rathod, the manager of M/s R K Associates and Hoteliers Private Limited, the catering service provider on

the train, Gupta managed to secure the correct bill and the appropriate pricing of ₹80 for the ordered four veg lunch meals.

However, Gupta expressed dissatisfaction with the quality of the food, citing discrepancies such as receiving only two chapatis instead of the promised four, watery lentils

instead of the specified thick one, and the absence of curd in the meal.

When questioned about these issues, the waiter claimed that the train's specific policy allowed only two chapatis, and curd was unavailable due to stock depletion. Furthermore, he admitted that the lentils contained only water as they did not have grains from their supplier and declined to disclose his name. Subsequently, Gupta observed vendors in the pantry car selling curd separately at ₹30-40 each.

In response to Gupta's complaint, Licensee contended that an investigation on their end revealed the food were sourced from an unauthorised vendor.

BJP, Sena leaders at war over access to elevated water tank

As the residents of the twin-city eagerly wait for the completion of the surya regional water supply scheme, local leaders of the BJP and the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv-Sena are at loggerheads over the issue of the approach road leading to the construction site of an elevated storage tank (ESR) on the hillocks located at Chene village near Kashimira.

Shiv Sena legislator Pratap Sarnaik alleged that he received a complaint from the Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) that the access road to ferry construction material for the mega ESR (having the capacity to store 45 MLD water) was blocked by a private company on the behest of a local BJP leader for the past couple of months.

Upon receiving the complaint, which could hamper the speed of the much-needed water supply project, Sarnaik along with his independent counterpart Geeta Jain accompanied by officials from the MMRDA, Mira Bhayandar Municipal Corporation (MBMC) and revenue department, inspected the site on Tuesday.

"It is highly condemnable that a political leader who claims himself to be a vikas purush (development man) for his own personal interests is creating obstacles for a project which is aimed at putting a permanent end to the water woes of the twin-city. However, I have arranged an alternative approach road to ensure that the work

With the surya dam at Dhamani village in Jawhar as the source of water, the MMRDA will provide a bulk water supply amounting to 403 million litres per day (MLD), which will be divided between Mira-Bhayandar and Vasai-Virar in a proportion of 218 MLD and 185 MLD, respectively. The master plan includes laying 176km of pipelines, 23 elevated storage reservoirs, and 38 feeder mains. Although MMRDA will lift water and channel it to the doorstep of the twin-city, the MBMC had to shoulder the responsibility of overhauling the entire internal pipework networking system.

is completed smoothly," said Sarnaik.

Responding to the charges, former BJP legislator Narendra Mehta who apparently holds a sway over the private company which owns the land parcel hurled a volley of allegations related to corruption and causing environmental damage against both the legislators. "The allegations are baseless and aimed at maligning my image and covering up their own failures. Despite having an alternative road, the company had granted access to the construction work. However, they not only took their own sweet time to complete the work, while damaging the private road but are also denying compensation," said Mehta. "We will bring the matter to the knowledge of the chief minister and deputy chief minister," said Jain.

Illegal liquor trade in Navi Mumbai, NCP wants probe

Around 15 liquor outlets in Thane district, including five in Navi Mumbai, continue to sell liquor despite their supply being halted due to unpaid bills. It is suspected that these shops may be involved in the illegal procurement of liquor.

Balasaheb Borkar, the secretary of the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), has written to excise minister Shambhuraje Desai, the excise commissioner, the collector, and other relevant officials, urging them to conduct an inquiry. Borkar alleges that these shops are illicitly sourcing liquor, resulting in a loss of revenue for the state government.

According to Borkar, the supply to these 15 liquor outlets in Thane was discontinued due to outstanding bills. Despite this, the outlets continued to sell liquor. This raises the question of where the stock for sale is coming from, especially considering that around ₹23 crore in bills is overdue.

Borkar's complaint highlights that traders appointed by the excise department to supply liquor to outlets in Thane have halted their deliveries to those with unpaid bills for the past 15 days. The outlets included in Navi Mumbai are Bipasha Wines, Manoj Wines, Yogesh Wines, Cheers Wines, and M G Wines. Borkar specifically points out that from October 16-30, these shops received no supply, yet they continued selling liquor.

All these liquor outlets are running under the management of a single group.
