- 2 This statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other recognized accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- 3 The format of the above results as prescribed in SEBI's Circular CIR/CFD/CMD/15/2015 dated 30th November, 2015 has been modified to comply with the requirements of SEBI's Circular dated 5th July, 2016, Ind AS and Schedule III [Division II] to the
- 4 Figures of previous reporting periods have been regrouped/ reclassified wherever necessary to correspond with the figures of the current reporting period.
- 5 During the quarter, the company has issued 23,88,055 number of Equity shares of Rs. 10/- each at a premium of Rs. 25/- to Promoter/Promoter group and Non Promoter group and has also issued 2,49,000 number of Compulsory Convertible Preference shares of Rs. 10/- each at a premium of Rs. 25/- to Promoter/Promoter group for a consideration other than cash. The above transaction is in principally approved by BSE Limited vide letter No. DCS/PRE/SID9/RE/3103/2018-19 on August 13, 2018.
- 6 During the quarter, the company has converted 10,66,875 warrants into 10,66,875 Equity shares of Rs. 10/- each at a premium of Rs. 10/- to Promoters on a preferential basis. The above transaction has been approved by BSE Limited vide letter no.
- 7 During the quarter, the company has purchased land as stock-in-trade along with transactions related to Trading of Goods hence there are two reporting segments of the company which are as follows
